GROWTH & CHANGE

I had a great group of vendors to work with last year and being fully prepared, we had very little hiccups in the office! Thank you everyone for your continued support and patience. You may now set up as early as 3pm on Friday for your vendor space. If you are camping, campers are always welcome as early as Thursday but we ask to **refrain from arriving between 11am-3pm on Friday** due to possible school tours.

SALES TAX

ALL vendors provide their sales tax permit number. By law, we are required to report the names of all vendors at the show, and to enforce the sales tax permit number. If we do not comply, we face substantial fines to our association. If you do not have a sales tax permit, simply fill out our form which will be in the office or you can find me in the barn.

ADMISSION

Admission is not included in your vendor fee. The fee is **\$10 which is not optional**. Please remember, the vendor space plus the admission fee for this two day event is less than many fees for other two day events vendors are able to attend throughout the year. Admission income is tracked and expensed out separately in our associations finances. Thank you for your understanding.

OFFICE LOCATION

I will be in the office again this year on Friday 3-7pm. Due to possible school tours, we ask that **vendors who would like to set up on Friday wait until 3pm to arrive on sight**.

THE BARN

These 10 spots have been in high demand as they are our only indoor booth locations. Please contact me to have your name put on a waiting list if you prefer an indoor booth. Note, that these spots will be full until one of the current vendors is unable to attend. **Barn booth registration MUST be mailed to me with fee no later than August 1st or I will begin contacting our growing waiting list.**

CAMPING

We continue the camping arrangements from previous years. The public is welcome to camp on the grounds in a self contained place or in primitive camping where there are no hook ups at no charge. Camping is available with hookups but these spots are very limited and reservations are required and vendors are not allowed to set up sales booths in this area as it is reserved for camping only. Vendors wishing to camp alongside their booth need to register for an extra large outdoor space at \$30. Please be prepared to pay \$10/day should you be able to hook up to electricity. Camping is available as early as Thursday prior to the event.
